Yesterday afternoon the Inyo County Sheriff's Office (ICSO) responded to the 300-block of South Pa Ha Lane in Bishop to contact Raymond Denver, a 42-year old man, who was wanted for kidnapping, vandalism and battery. ICSO had originally received a call for service the night of July 6th just before 11:00pm. According to the reporting party –Raymond Denver had been witnessed forcing a female into his vehicle following a domestic dispute.

As the Sheriff's Deputy and Tribal Police were approaching Denver, an extremely aggressive dog advanced from behind a residence and attempted to bite the Sheriff's Deputy. In an effort to protect himself, the Deputy fired one shot at the dog. Animal Control responded and transported the animal to a veterinarian where it expired from the gunshot wound.

Denver was taken into custody without further incident and is currently being held at the Inyo County Jail under felony charges. Bail has been set for \$250,000.
